Resolution # 08-1212-405

Final Adoption of Amendment to Budget and Appropriations Ordinance

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHERAS, the Tribal Council adopted Ordinance # 04-100-04 <u>Budget and</u> <u>Appropriations Ordinance</u> on October 6, 2004 which states that the Ogema must submit the tribal budget proposal to the Tribal Council by October 31st and that the tribal budget shall be approved by the Tribal Council in the month of October; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted emergency amendments to the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance by Resolution #08-0123-21; and
- WHEREAS, those emergency amendments allowed the Ogema to authorize budget modifications, without Tribal Council approval, for amounts that were less than or equal to 10% of a Department's overall budget; and

WHEREAS, the emergency amendments were never permanently adopted; and

- WHEREAS, Tribal Council rescinded Resolution #08-0123-21 by Resolution #08-1015-345; and
- WHEREAS, the Office of the Ogema had requested that Tribal Council post the revisions for public comment and permanently adopt the amended Ordinance; and
- WHEREAS, the amendments to the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance were posted from October 16, 2008 through November 16, 2008 and no public comments were received.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby adopts the amendments to the <u>Budget and Appropriations</u> <u>Ordinance</u>, Ordinance # 04-100-04, for immediate implementation.
