## Resolution #16-0406-101

Acceptance of Little River Casino Resort FY2016 Audit by RubinBrown, LLP

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(I) to take action, not inconsistent with the Constitution or Federal law, which is necessary and proper to carry out the sovereign powers of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has authorized the development of a gaming enterprise by adoption of the <u>Gaming Ordinance</u>, # 10-400-01, and created the Little River Casino Resort by adoption of an enterprise charter in Resolution # 99-0314-07; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has adopted the <u>Gaming Commission Ordinance</u>, #04-400-04, which created the Gaming Commission and authorized it to regulate the gaming operations, including the specific responsibility to engage auditors to conduct an annual of the gaming operations; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Casino Resort conducts its operations in accordance with the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, Tribe-State Compact, Federal laws, Gaming Ordinance #10-400-01, and Gaming Commission regulations, any or all of which require an annual audit of the gaming operations; and

- WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission recommended and the Tribal Council approved engaging RubinBrown, LLP to conduct the Fiscal Year 2015, 2016, and 2017 audit of the Little River Casino Resort by adoption of Resolution #15-0610-191; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council received the Little River Casino Resort FY2015 final audit report from RubinBrown, LLP; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was presented with the final audit report from RubinBrown, LLP on April 4, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby accepts the Little River Casino Resort FY2015 audit from RubinBrown, LLP; and authorizes its submission to NIGC.
