Approval of submission of Grant Application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency – Performance Partnership Grant (PPG) containing Indian Environmental General Assistance Program (IGAP), Clean Water Act 106 (CWA 106), Clean Water Act 319 (CWA 319), and Comprehensive Environmental Response, and Compensation Act Section 128(a) (Brownfields) funds for FY 2017 and FY 2018

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the EPA has funding available for grants to establish and enhance a Tribal Performance Partnership Program,
- NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves a submission to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for a Performance Partnership Grant Program for \$818,588 for fiscal year 2017 and fiscal year 2018.
