Resolution #16-0608-173

Cancelling the Contract with Kaya Clark - Warpaint for the position of Host Drum for the 2016 Manistee Jiingtamok approved by Resolution #16-0518-150 and entering into a new contract with John Bryant – Warpaint for the position of Host Drum for the 2016 Manistee Jiingtamok

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for Key Persons for the 2016 Jiingtamok sponsored by the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians and the Tribal Historic Preservation Department.
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in receipt of the contract for services with Kaya Clark Warpaint for the position of Host Drum for the 2016 Jiingtamok, and
- IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians approve the submitted contract with John Bryant Warpaint for \$3,500.00 and local overnight accommodations for 6 rooms for 2 nights
