Resolution #16-0629-187

Approval to renew Insurance Policies for Commercial Property, General Liability, Business Auto, Commercial Crime and Workers Compensation with Tribal First through Agent Stephen Madigan, LLC to Provide Insurance Coverage for Little River Band of Ottawa Indians, Little River Trading Post, and Muskegon Gaming Development

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council met with the Chief Financial Officer during agenda review held on June 20, 2016 to review the recommended insurance renewals being proposed for Property, General Liability, Business Auto, Commercial Crime and Workers Compensation for the period July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, recommended changes to coverage, additions and deletions were noted and changes were made and included by the Agent in the final insurance coverage proposal.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the Property, General Liability, Business Auto, Commercial Crime and Workers Compensation Insurance policies for the Tribal Government and its entities and authorizes the Tribal Ogema to sign and execute the contract for the period July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT nothing in the contract, nor in this resolution ratifying the contract, shall be considered an express or implied waiver of the Tribe's sovereign immunity.
