Resolution #16-0824-242

Approving the Submission of a Grant Application for Continuation Funding for Little River Band of Ottawa Indians under the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) to the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) for FY 2016-2017 in an amount of \$92,092.00

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, there is a continuing need to support the efforts of low-income Tribal families to obtain nutritional foods; and
- WHEREAS, the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations is a program administered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture and is dedicated to assisting needy tribal families with nutritional foods made available through agricultural market surpluses; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has participated in this program for many years and wishes to continue this program for eligible Tribal families in need.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves of the grant application under the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations to the U.S. Department of Agriculture for FY 2016-2017 in the amount of \$92,092.00.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians, by this resolution, authorizes the Tribal Ogema to execute submission documents as required and also commits a total in-kind match of \$47,735.00 to support the operation of the Little River Band Food Distribution Program for FY 2016-2017, which brings the total project cost to \$139,827.00.
