Ratification of Tree Removal Agreement with the Manistee Blacker Airport Authority

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is vested with the authority, under Article IV, Section 7(b), to ratify contracts to be entered into by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe owns certain lands located within the airport approach area for aircraft takeoff and landing at the Manistee Blacker Airport; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe is willing to permit the removal of trees that are potential obstructions to aircraft landing or taking off from the Manistee Blacker Airport; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that entering into this Tree Removal Agreement with the Manistee Blacker Airport Authority will resolve the approach obstruction

issue for the airport and reasonably compensate the Tribe for the trees that will be removed from the Tribal land, and, as such, is in the best interest of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to be a waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians or any of its subordinate enterprises or entities.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the Tribal Ogema to execute this Tree Removal Agreement with the Manistee Blacker Airport Authority incorporating the contents of this resolution.
