Resolution #16-1207-388

Approving the FY 2017 Resort Operating and Capital Expenditure Budget

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) of the Constitution to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is empowered by Article IV, Section 7(a) of the Constitution to establish laws through the enactment of ordinances and adoption of resolutions; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is empowered by Article IV, Section 7(f) of the Constitution of the Tribe to create subordinate organizations and to delegate to such organizations the power to manage the enterprises of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted the Gaming Enterprise(s) Oversight Act of 2010, Ordinance #10-800-03, by Tribal Council Resolution on August 10, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Section 7.02 of the Gaming Enterprise(s) Oversight Act of 2010 requires the General Manager shall prepare, or cause to be prepared, a separate proposed Annual Budget for each Gaming Enterprise in accordance with the power of the Ogema to prepare and present an annual budget to Tribal Council under Article V, Section 5(a)(5) of the Constitution, in accordance with the Budget and Appropriations Act of 2013 (Ordinance #13-100-04), and in accordance with the power of Tribal Council to approve or amend the annual budget; and

WHEREAS, Tribal Council has been presented with the FY 2017 Resort Operating and Capital Expenditure Budget and finds it to be in the best interests of the Tribe and Resort; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the FY 2017 Operating and Capital Expenditure Budget.

CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION
