## Resolution #17-0412-135

To authorize the Construction Project Task Force to oversee the Fair Market Residential
Unit Development at Aki maadiziwin

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized to establish subordinate bodies and to delegate decision-making authority to such bodies in accordance with Article IV, Section 7(f); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the body established pursuant to Resolution #08-0827-283, known as the Construction Project Task Force, be empowered with all project management and decision-making authority necessary to facilitate the development of the Fair Market Residential Rental Development at Aki manadiziwin, Manistee, Michigan.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council does hereby reaffirm the purposes of the current Construction Project Task Force and to its authority to include all necessary project management and decision-making authority during the subsequent planning and construction process for the Aki maadiziwin Fair Market Rental Development with the stipulation that all singular expenditures for the project over \$50,000.00 be simultaneously approved by Tribal Council.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council does hereby grant all necessary authority and management, including the budget, work authorization orders, and decision-making responsibilities with respect to the planning and construction process for the Aki maadiziwin Fair Market Rental Development to the Construction Project Task Force subject the limiting provisions in the preceding paragraph.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this subordinate body, the Construction Project Task Force, shall be required to act by motion and roll call vote, with majority vote prevailing, on any matter that comes for approval or action of the Task Force.
