Resolution #17-0426-155

Continuing the Compensation for the Tribal Council

WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Aníshinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council identified the compensation levels for the Speaker, Recorder and Councilors by Resolution #03-0419-100; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council continued the compensation under Resolution #05-0511-197, Resolution #07-0321-147, #09-0415-99, #11-0420-132, #13-0424-085 and #15-0415-115; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that the current compensation levels set remains to be an appropriate compensation level and that no changes are necessary;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council held a work session on March 30, 2017, to review the compensation levels of elected officials.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the continued application of Tribal Council annual compensation without change as follows:

Tribal Council Speaker:	\$56,617.60
Tribal Council Recorder:	\$56,035.20
Council Members:	\$55,827.20

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council directs that this resolution shall continue in effect unless specifically amended or rescinded by subsequent resolution adopted by the Tribal Council.

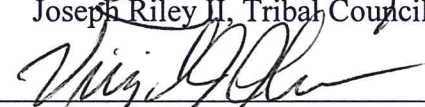
IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this compensation resolution may be subject to amendment in order to comply with the General Membership enactment of compensation conditions for payment.
