## Resolution #18-0124-029

Re-Approval of Membership to Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee by Tribal Council and Tribal Ogema

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Strategic Gaming Reserve does set aside funds for endeavors that are important to the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approved Resolution # 18-0110-008, which approved the membership with the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the amount of the membership is actually more than the approved amount in Resolution # 18-0110-008; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council hereby appoints the following persons as Delegates and 06/29/18
Alternates to fulfill their responsibilities as Federal Legislative Liaisons on behalf of Little River Band of Ottawa Indians.

Delegate: Joseph Riley, II, Tribal Council Recorder

Delegate: Shannon Crampton, Tribal Council

Delegate: Sandy Lewis, Tribal Council

WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema and Tribal Council agree that a \$33,900 membership fee to the Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee is appropriate in order to attend the dinners and meetings held by the DSCC.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT that The Tribal Council approves the membership fee to Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee in the amount of \$33,900 from the Strategic Gaming Reserve #8300-000-5302.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council rescinds Resolution # 18-0110-008.
