- Acceptance of funds from the Department of Housing & Urban Development, 2020-2021 Indian Community Development Block Grant-CARES Grant and approving modification to the Operating Budget MB-2020-053 in the amount of \$898,560
- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 9(i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe is authorized to accept Department of Housing and Urban Development funds under the authority of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, 24 CFR Part 1003, Notice 2020-05 and any applicable ICDBG polices; and

- WHEREAS, the acceptance of funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development, 2020-21 ICDBG CARES grant funds to reimburse allowable costs to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19, that were incurred by LRBOI beginning January 21, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, the LRBOI Construction Task Force is assigned oversight of expenditures for the 2020-21 ICDBG CARES grant related construction project.
- NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves acceptance of grant funds and modification to the Operating Budget for the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year 2020, in the amount of \$898,560, from the Department of Housing and Urban Development, ICDBG CARES Act grant.
