Ratification of Agreement with Worldwide Casino Consulting in the Amount of \$5,500.00

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7 (a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council pursuant to the Constitution Article IV, Section 7 (b), authorizes and ratifies contracts negotiated by the Ogema; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, pursuant to Gaming Commission Ordinance # 04-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Tribe and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally licensed gaming activities; and

- WHEREAS, pursuant to the Gaming Commission Ordinance #40-400-04, Section 6.02 (g), the Gaming Commission shall arrange for training for Gaming Commissioners, Gaming Commission employees, and others; and
- WHEREAS, the Surveillance Department Budget does include funds to cover this expenditure and a proposal was obtained from Worldwide Casino Consulting to provide a three-day games protection training (many examples of casino cheating and game procedure violation as well as new high tech casino cheating methods) during the week of June 20, 2022, for \$5,500.00; and
- WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission approved the agreement with Worldwide Casino Consulting by Gaming Commission Resolution #GC22-0517-03 and is now requesting Tribal Council's ratification.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the Tribal Ogema to execute the agreement with Worldwide Casino Consulting to provide a training for Gaming Commissioners, Gaming Commission employees, and others.
