- Approval of the Supplemental Appropriation 2022-03-2nd QTR to fund Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Jingtamok in the amount of \$20,000
- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council will need these extra dollars allotted into their 5202 Tribal Activities Budget, and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council is currently planning and implementing the LRBOI Jingtamok during weekly Council Work Sessions, and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council has agreed that any Jingtamok income and any unspent budgeted funds will be returned to General Fund, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received a Funds Availability Certification, #2022-009, from the Accounting Department signed by the Chief Financial Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Appropriation of funds from the General Fund will require a modification of the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2022, which was approved by Resolution #22-0401-055, and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves a modification to the Operating Budget for the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year 2022 to include an appropriation of \$20,000 from the General Fund Reserves to fund 1020-100 Tribal Council 5202 Tribal Activities.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this supplemental appropriation shall be allocated in the 2nd quarter.
