## **Resolution #22-1012-173**

Approval of Supplemental Appropriation 2022-04-4th QTR to fund the 2022 Hurricane Ian Catastrophic Emergency Assistance Relief and Recovery Program in the amount of \$154,000

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received a Certification of Availability of Funds, #2022-017, from the Accounting Department signed by the Chief Financial Officer; and
- WHEREAS, the appropriation of funds from the General Fund will require a modification of the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2022, which was approved on April 01, 2022, by Resolution #22-0401-055; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves a modification to the Operating Budget for the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year 2022 to include an appropriation of \$154,000 from the General Fund to fund the 2022 Hurricane Ian Catastrophic Emergency Assistance Relief and Recovery Program.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this supplemental appropriation shall be allocated in the 4th quarter. Funds shall be allocated as follows:

Program # 1080-137 Members Assistance Department Acct. #5204- Client Services \$154,000

FINALLY IT IS RESOLVED THAT the funds allocated are restricted to the 2022 Hurricane Ian Catastrophic Emergency Assistance Relief and Recovery Program and shall not be used for other Members Assistance Programs.
