**Resolution #23-0322-043**

*Approval of ZDN Consulting Agreement to provide Fiber Splice and Troubleshooting to the Governments Properties*

WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Aníshinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals education, and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing and Procurement Regulations, #R100-01;AC-01, have been approved by the Tribal Ogema and Tribal Council which directs that authorization expenditures in excess of \$25,000.01 be made by the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received the Tribal Master Agreement for Services

and quote from ZDN Consulting to provide services to the Tribal Government properties; and

WHEREAS, the agreement and terms have been reviewed by Executive Legal; and

WHEREAS, ZDN Consulting will provide fiber splicing and troubleshooting to reconnect the government building to the NGLC Building, including the Gaming Commission and clinic, the Food Distribution Building, the Utilities Department and the Justice Center; and

WHEREAS, the costs for the services, estimated to be \$1,440.00 will come out of the IT 2023 Budget.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the ratification of the Master Agreement for Services with ZDN Consulting Agreement to provide Fiber Splice and Troubleshooting to the Governments Properties.
