## **Resolution #23-0329-045**

Approval to Submit to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) the FY 2020 -2025 Indian Housing Block Grant CARES-Grant Annual Performance Report (APR) for the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians as developed by the Housing Department

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe is required to submit a Tribal Annual Performance Report to HUD on a annual basis, the submittal of which provides HUD the basis of expenditures NAHASDA (Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act) funding during the period that LRBOI's Indian Housing Block Grant-CARES Grant; and

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WHEREAS, the Housing Department readied this submission to HUD which was reviewed by the Tribal Ogema's Office and finally by the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council and found to be in accordance with the long term interests of the Tribe and its Citizens during the COVID-19 pandemic in terms of its HUD funded housing related activities and in accordance with NAHASDA regulations pertaining to eligible activities per the Indian Housing Plan (IHP).

WHEREAS, this submittal is due to HUD within 90 days from the end of our fiscal year; and

IT IS NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians whereby approves the submission of the 2022 Annual Performance Report to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for FY 2022 IHBG-CATES grant.
