Resolution #23-0621-087

Appropriating Funds for Expenditures during the Third Quarter of FY2023.

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has adopted the Budget and Appropriations Act of 2013, Ordinance #13-100-04; and
- WHEREAS, Section 5.07 of the Budget and Appropriations Act of 2013 requires that the Tribal Council appropriate funds for expenditures quarterly.
- WHEREAS, Comptroller General works with Tribal Accounting department to develop the Annual and Quarterly Appropriation plan.

WHEARAS, Tribal Council was emailed copies of the Annual and Quarterly scheduled Appropriation plan for 2023 on December 19, 2022, March 21, 2023 and June 12, 2023.

WHEARAS, Tribal Council held a work session on June 20 2023 to discuss annual and quarterly appropriations.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby appropriates the amount of \$6,004,224.50 for expenditures during the fiscal quarter beginning July 1, 2023.
