Ratification of Agreement with North American Video for Synectics Synergy Secure Software Maintenance and Remote Technical Support in the Amount of \$16,455.00

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council pursuant to the Constitution Article IV Section 7 (b), authorizes and ratifies contracts negotiated by the Ogema; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, pursuant to Gaming Commission Ordinance # 04-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Triba and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally licensed gaming activities; and

- WHEREAS, the Surveillance digital system requires properly functioning and updated software to operate properly and also requires remote technical services and support; and
- WHEREAS, the software maintenance and remote warranty/support package will expire on July 31, 2023; and
- WHEREAS, the preferred vendor (sole source) for the software maintenance and remote support is North American Video based on the fact that the current digital system was purchased through North American Video.
- WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission approved the one-year agreement with North American Video by Gaming Commission Resolution #GC23-0725-06 and is now requesting Tribal Council's ratification.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the Tribal Ogema to execute the agreement with North American Video to provide a one-year software maintenance and remote technical support.

CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION
