Resolution # 24-0918-162

Acceptance of funds from U.S. Department of Agriculture – 2024 FDPIR Supplemental Distribution Grant and approving a modification to the Operating Budget MB2024-43, in the amount of \$21,800

WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Aníshinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of grant funds from the U.S. Department of Agriculture requires a modification of the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2024; and

WHEREAS, additional funds were authorized by FDPIR for the purchase of domestically grown and produced foods which will alleviate supply chain challenges and national warehouse delays which has impacted FDPIR inventory levels.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby accepts \$21,800 into the Operating Budget for the Tribal Government for the Fiscal Year 2024 to include grant funds from the U.S. Department of Agriculture – 2024 FDPIR Supplemental Distribution Grant – Fund #4568 as follows:
