## Resolution #24 -0925-177

Approval of Expenditure for a JCB 3CX Compact with Snow Blower for the Utility Department in the amount of \$135,969.65 Utilitizing ARPA Funds 4996-000-6100

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Purchasing and Procurement Regulations, #R100-01;AC-01, have been approved by the Tribal Ogema and Tribal Council which directs that authorization expenditures in excess of \$25,000.01 be made by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Utility Department is in need of an upgrade for the backhoe with greater digging depth to maintain the water distribution and sewer collection systems as well as roads maintenance; protection of the public health and environment; and

WHEREAS, to protect the peace and safety of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians, the equipment and vehicles purchased by the Utilities Department supports the necessary infrastructure to minimize COVID-19 exposure and the investments in water and sewer infrastructure is a standalone approved use for the funds.

IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the purchase of a JCB 3 CX Compact with Snow blower under ARPA funding 4996-000-6100 for the protection of the public health and environment, and incorporating the contents of this resolution in the amount of \$135,969.65
