## **Resolution #24-1218-255**

Ratification of Maintenance Service Contract Renewal with HID Global Corporation in the Amount of \$1,413.00

- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Anišhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council pursuant to the Constitution Article IV Section 7 (b), authorizes and ratifies contracts negotiated by the Ogema; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received a maintenance service contract renewal with HID Global Corporation in the amount of \$1,413.00 to service the Gaming Commission's livescan fingerprint scanner system; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, pursuant to Gaming Commission Ordinance # 04-400-04, created a Gaming Commission and delegated to such Commission the authority to regulate all gaming activities authorized by the Tribe and to enforce all Tribal and federal laws governing the conduct of Tribally licensed gaming activities; and

- WHEREAS, the Gaming Ordinance #10-400-01 Section 10.03 (r) provides that all applications for licensure, fingerprints shall be taken by the regulatory agency and forwarded to the NIGC for processing through the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the National Criminal Information Center to determine the applicant's criminal history, if any; and
- WHEREAS, the livescan fingerprint scanner system requires maintenance, software upgrades, and technical support to operate efficiently and without disruption; and
- WHEREAS, the maintenance service contract expired on December 1, 2024; and
- WHEREAS, the preferred vendor (sole source) for the maintenance service contract is HID Global Corporation is the distributor of our existing equipment and is best suited to handle the maintenance agreement.
- WHEREAS, the Gaming Commission approved the renewal contract by Gaming Commission Resolution #GC24-1210-15 and is now requesting Tribal Council ratification.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the Tribal Ogema to execute the maintenance service contract renewal with HID Global Corporation.
