## **Resolution #25-0604-122**

Approval of Budget Modification MB2025-26; authorizing the return of funds from U.S. Department of the Treasury – Emergency Rental Assistance Program in the amount of \$3,919.50

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approved Resolution #21-0317-068, which accepted funds from U.S. Department of Treasury Emergency Rental Assistance Program funding in the amount of \$365,299.91; and

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- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approved Resolution # 21-0331-085, which accepted funds from U.S. Department of Treasury Emergency Rental Assistance Program funding in the amount of \$16,938.61; and
- WHEREAS, a grant closeout was done in January 2023 and there was an error in the closeout amount; and
- WHEREAS, a return of funds needs to be completed in the amount of \$3,919.50 and will require a modification of the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2025.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves a modification to the Operating Budget for the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year 2025 to include a return in funding from U.S. Department of Treasury – Emergency Rental Assistance Program funding in the amount of \$3,919.50.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council authorizes the return of \$3,919.50 to the U.S. Department of the Treasury.
