- Master Agreement for contract for services between Little River Band of Ottawa Indians ("Band"), and J. Chad Professional Training, LLC (Referred to as Tall Cop) for presentation on April 14, 2026
- WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziíbi Daáwaa Aníšhinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August 24, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the acceptance of contract from J. Chad Professional Training, LLC to have Tall Cop presentation event at the Little River Casino & Resort on April 14, 2026.
- WHEREAS, nothing in this Contract shall be construed to be a waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Little River Band Of Ottawa Indians or any of its subordinate enterprises or entities; and
- WHEREAS, this Contract, and any disputes arising out of this contract, shall be governed by the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal court. This Contract, and any

disputes arising out of the Contract, shall be governed by the laws of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the contract and funding it from the budget the State of Michigan Opioid Settlement Funds (OSF – Fund #4582) for Fiscal year 2025-2026 for the payment for services of \$29,100.00.
