Resolution #25-0910-205

Amendment to the Budget and Appropriations Act of 2013, Ordinance #13-100-04, Article V. Section 5.13 to remove subsection (e).

- WHEREAS, the status of the Gaa Ching Ziibi Daawaa Anishinaabek (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on July 11, 2016 which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on August24,2016; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized by Article IV, Section 7(a)(l) and (2) to exercise the inherent powers of the Tribe by establishing laws through the enactment of ordinances and adoption of resolutions to govern the conduct of Tribal Members and others within the Tribe's jurisdiction and to promoted, protect and provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tribe and its members; and

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted the Budget and Appropriations Act of 2013, Ordinance #13-100-04 and has most recently amended this Ordinance with Resolution #22-0915-160; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Tribal Council finds Action is required to make amendments to Article V, Section 5.13 to remove subsection (e); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has held several work sessions for discussion and posted the ordinance for 30 day for input from membership; and
- WHEREAS, the Ordinance 30 day posted ended on August 18 and Tribal Council held its final work session to discuss 30 Day Posting concerns from membership on August 19th; and
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Tribal Council adopts the amendment to the Budget and Appropriations Act of 2013, Ordinance #13-100-04, Article V, Section 5.13, the removal of subsection (e).
