RESOLUTION 93-01

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is seeking the restoration of our historic and rightful status as a federally-recognized tribal government; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is preparing a petition for federal acknowledgement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, U.S. Department of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, we are dependent on grant funds and contractual expertise to assist us in accomplishing this important work; and

WHEREAS, we have recently been notified of our grant award from the Administration for Native Americans, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services in the amount of \$129,000 to provide financial assistance in accomplishing this work;

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby requests funding from the Campaign for Human Development in the amount of \$74,000, as a matching grant which will enable us to complete the federal recognition petition by the end of 1994.
