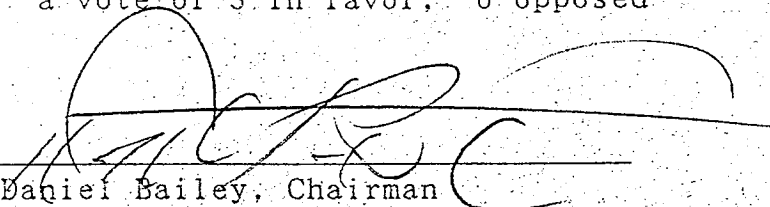

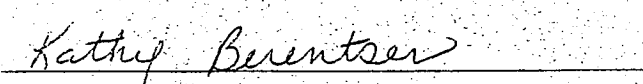
WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians would like to work in a cooperative manner with the other federally recognized tribes in Michigan.
