WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a federally recognized tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, dated September 21, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is dedicated to the preservation of its history including historical documents and photographs; and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians desires to afford its members and others the opportunity to have access to a well-ordered and professional historical archive/research library;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby supports the request of the Education Committee and the Education Programs Coordinator to apply for a FY1996 Special Projects Grant under the Library Services for Indian Tribes and Hawaiian Natives Program. The intended purpose of said grant is to hire a certified library scientist/archivist to organize existing and future documents, photographs, and other archival information into an accessible archival collection.
