Whereas, the non-profit SAGE Council is dedicated to the preservation and teaching of the traditions, culture, and language of the Anishnabek,

Now, therefore, be it known that the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby supports the SAGE Council in its efforts to provide for the cultural and traditional renaissance through an inter-Tribal approach.
