RESOLUTION NO. 97-0209-04

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a federally recognized tribe reaffirmed under Public Law 103-324 enacted on September 21, 1994; and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to encourage and assist Tribal Members who are pursuing vocational training; and

WHEREAS, The Education Committee of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians approved by consensus the program requirements and guidelines for implementation of a BIA Vocational Education Assistance Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians approves the eligibility requirements, funding priorities, appeal process, and financial need assessment for the BIA Vocational Education Assistance Program and authorizes the Education Committee to begin implementation of the above named program.
