RESOLUTION NO. 97-0209- 05

WHEREAS, P.L. 103-324 was signed into law on September 21, 1994, which reaffirmed the status of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians as a federally recognized tribe; and

WHEREAS, prior to enactment of P.L. 103-324, the Little River Band of Ottawa could not access Indian Health Service programs and therefore has many unmet health needs; and

WHEREAS, the United States government has proclaimed Indian selfdetermination as a goal of the Federal government, pursuant to P.L. 93-638; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Administrator of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is authorized to conduct negotiations with the Indian Health Service and is directed to administer the following project: Little River Health Management Capacity Development, until such time as the Tribal Council determines otherwise; and

BE IT RESOLVED, the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians authorizes the submission of the Tribal Management Grant application to the Indian Health Service on or before February 28,1997; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, all grants, supplements and revisions initiated during the approved budget period must be accompanied by certification of prior approval by the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians.
