WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians of Michigan is a federally recognized tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, enacted on September 21, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe and its members are eligible for all services and benefits provided by the federal government to Indians as members of federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band Tribal Council is authorized under P.L. 103-324 to serve as the interim governing body for the Tribe and to conduct business on behalf of the interests of Tribal members; and

WHEREAS, The Tribe is authorized to contract federal funds under the authority of the Indian Self-Determination Act (P.L. 93-638), as amended, to implement and administer services for its members.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby requests to contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to provide services under the authority of the Indian Self-Determination Act (P.L. 93-638) and authorizes the submittal of a contract proposal to the Michigan Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairperson of the Little River Band Tribal Council, or his designee, is authorized to negotiate and execute a Self-Determination Contract, and any amendments, and is also authorized to serve as the Tribal Senior Official Representative for purposes of the contract.
