## SUPPORTING A GRANT APPLICATION FOR FOOD COMMODITY DISTRIBUTION SITE

To support a grant application to the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservation (FDPIR) FY 1997/98 for the implementation of a Food Commodity Distribution Site.

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a federally recognized tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, enacted on September 21, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe and its members are eligible for all services and benefits provided by the federal government to Indians, as affirmed by P.L. 103-324, because of their status as enrolled members of a federally recognized tribe; and

WHEREAS, the current Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is authorized by P.L. 103-324 to conduct business on behalf of the Tribe until such time as a new constitution and by-laws are duly adopted, pursuant to an election conducted by the Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the successful completion of objectives in the USDA FDPIR proposal would enhance the health of our Tribal members, by Distributing and increasing the awareness of good nutrition amongst our members,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council support the submission of the proposal for a Food Commodity Site to the USDA on or before August 15, 1997.
