Resolution No. #97-0929-93

Supporting Submission of Grant Application to the Traverse Area Arts  
Council for a series of cultural activities jointly Sponsored by the  
Education & Cultural Preservation Committees

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a federally  
recognized tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, enacted on  
September 21, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe and its members are eligible for all services  
and benefits provided by the federal government to Indians, as reaffirmed  
by P.L. 103-324, because of their status as enrolled members of a  
federally recognized tribe; and

WHEREAS, the current Tribal Council of the Little River Band of  
Ottawa Indians is authorized by P.L. 103-324 to conduct business on  
behalf of the Tribe until such time as a new constitution and by-laws are  
duly adopted, pursuant to an election conducted by the Secretary of the  
Interior; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, Article VII, Section I(j) of the Tribal  
Constitution is authorized to provide for the health, safety, morals, and  
welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council believes that the cultural activities  
are a critical priority for the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the current Indian Health Services funding available to  
the Tribe is insufficient to meet the needs of the Little River Band Tribal  
Elders; and




WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to secure additional funding from the Traverse Area Arts Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians authorizes the submission of a grant application for a series of cultural activities to be jointly planned by the Tribe's Cultural Preservation and Educational committees on or before the application deadline of October 3, 1997.

### CERTIFICATION OF ADOPTION

This resolution was adopted by the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians at its Regular Session held on July 7, 1997, by a vote of 6 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 absent, and 0 abstentions. A quorum of the Tribal Council being present for such vote.
