**INDIAN RESERVATION ROADS (IRR) INVENTORY
& CONSTRUCTION PRIORITY LIST**

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156(25 U.S.C. Sec. 1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and


WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians and its members are eligible for all services and benefits by the Federal Government to Indian Tribes; and


WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians desires to improve the road system serving the Reservation community; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians submits an Inventory of Roads and Bridges to the BIA as the official and current Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) Inventory and current Road Construction Priority List for; BIA Routes US Hwy 31, M-22, and Dontz Road for the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians.
