Support and Approval of Tribal Participation in Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc. Proposed JTPA Program for Fiscal Year 1999

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a federally recognized tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, enacted on September 21, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is descended from, and is the political successor to, certain Grand River Ottawa Bands which were signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491), as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, enacted on September 21, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is a member of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc., an inter-tribal organization that promotes coordination of services, funding and programs for Federally recognized tribes in the State of Michigan; and

WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc., has developed and submitted its Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) annual plan to the U.S. Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council supports the goals of the JTPA plans submitted by Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc., and finds that it is in its best interest to participate in the consortium of Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan constituent Tribes to receive funds and administer programs under the JTPA Section 401 program, including the Title IV-A and Title II-B program funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby desires to participate in and supports the efforts of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc., to continue as a Section 401 JTPA grantee for Fiscal Year 1999.
