## RESOLUTION 99-0803 - 01

## LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSITANCE FY 1999 -2000

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156(25U.S.C. Sec. 1300k et seq.) (hereinafter "Little River Act"); and

WHEREAS, The Tribe and its members are eligible for all services and benefits provided by the federal government to Indians, as reaffirmed by P.L. 103-324, because of their status as enrolled members of a federally recognized tribe, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 1 of the Constitution, is authorized to represent the Tribe in its relations with other organizations, in a manner consistent with the Tribal Constitution; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Ogema, pursuant to Article V, Section 5 of the Tribal Constitution, is authorized to represent the Tribe in its relations with other organizations, in a manner consistent with the Tribal Constitution; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council is authorized to contract for federal funds under the authority of the Indian Self-Determination Act (P.L. 93-638, as amended), and to implement and administer services for its members, and

WHEREAS, The Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act authorizes the governing body of the Tribe to appoint, select, or designate a Tribally Designated Housing Entity (TDHE) for the purposes of administering, and operating a tribal housing program; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has under its Housing ordinance, designated the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Housing Commission as its TDHE to administer a broad range of housing programs, including those programs funded by the Department of Housing and Urban

Development (HUD) for low income Tribal members and other programs as may become available; and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indian Housing Commission desires to participate in the FY 2000 "Low Income Energy Assistance Program" administered by the Department of Health and Human Service – Office of Family Assistance; and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indian Housing Commission will prepare application and program implementation of the Tribal LIHEAP Program and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes, Executive Housing Director, Laurie Eggert, to sign, negotiate and execute the documents and grant assurances, on behalf of the Tribe, to obtain a grant award for the purposes of developing, enhancing and implementing Energy Assistance Services for Tribal members.
