ORDER REGARDING TRIBAL COURT OPERATIONS THROUGH APRIL 30, 2020

On March 17, 2020, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians, a federally recognized American Indian Tribe and sovereign Native Nation, closed the Tribal Government until March 30, 2020, for the health, safety, and well-being of the tribal citizens, employees, and the community.

On March 23, 2020, a decision was made to extend the closure until April 13, 2020, and on April 7, 2020, the Ogema, by Executive Order, extended the closure through April 30, 2020.

Accordingly, the Tribal Court is closed, except for limited matters as stated below.

All matters scheduled for hearing during this time are hereby adjourned until further Order of the Court.

All timelines and due dates, except for Child Support payments, are hereby suspended until May 1, 2020. This includes timelines in Orders of the Court regarding all cases pending and for filling of new cases. This applies retroactively to March 16, 2020.

All probationers are still subject to the terms and conditions of probation, except for in person reporting. Contact the Court for further instruction.

All arraignments will be conducted via phone conference.

The Court will hear emergency matters, requests for Warrants, requests for Personal Protection Orders, and Personal Protection Order violations via phone conference.
