ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER: 2021-005

ORDER REGARDING RE-OPENING OF JUSTICE CENTER BUILDING AND COURT OPERATIONS EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021

On March 17, 2020, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians, a federally recognized American Indian Tribe and sovereign Native Nation, closed the Tribal Government until March 30, 2020, for the health, safety, and well-being of the tribal citizens, employees, and the community.

On March 23, 2020, a decision was made to extend the closure until April 13, 2020, on April 7, 2020, the Ogema, by Executive order, extended the closure through April 30, 2020, on April 24, 2020, extended the closure on May 15, 2020, and on May 11, 2020, the Ogema, but Executive Order, extended the closure through May 27, 2020, the Ogema issued another Executive Order extending the closure through July 31, 2020. On July 22, 2020, another Executive Order was entered regarding partial openings of Government Buildings. In response to that order, the Court issued Administrative Order 020-007. On June 25, 2021 the Ogema issued an Executive Order regarding building re-openings, and then another one regarding the Justice Center. This Administrative Order follows.

The Justice Center Building is closed to the public, except by appointment only until further order of the Court, or by Executive Order of the Ogema. If you need an appointment, contact the office you wish to make an appointment with. You may contact the Court for appointments with the Court at 231-398-3406.

All Court Operations as stated in Administrative Order 020-007 remains in full effect.
