   Commissioner Cross also stated that his staff in the family Services Department has been referring their clients to Chi Ishobak for financial services. Tom stated that he would contact Shawn to see how things are going on his end.
- SBLA Revision Tom stated that this is done. Tribal Council will be posting this for the 30 day comment period soon.
- Commerce Corner all in attendance mentioned that since the departure of Glenn Zaring there has been communication problems with the Public Affairs office. Tom stated that he would mention this to the Ogema to see if it can be resolved.
- By-Law review Minor changes were completed by Commissioner Cross and reviewed by the Commission. Tom stated that some of the wording in the by-laws might place the Commission in a difficult position as the language places the Commission in a position of responsibility over the Commerce Departments internal policies, forms, and programs. These duties are not what the Commission has been doing and there needs to be some clarification. Commissioner Lewis stated that she would like some clarification on the wording. Commissioner Cross suggested a work session with Tribal Council to ask for clarification as to the intent of the Commission from this point forward. Cross stated that if the Commission was to start fulfilling the duties as listed in the by-laws, more meetings per month would be required.
