

# LITTLE RIVER BAND OF OTTAWA INDIANS POSITION VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

# **Position:** Conservation Officer – (Road Patrol Officer when needed) Public Safety Department - (1) Full Time – UPDATED

**Summary:** This position is responsible for the enforcement of tribal conservation laws and regulations, and the protection of wildlife, fisheries, and tribal-owned land within the reservation and ceded territories. Enforcement of Tribal, Federal, and State laws and ordinances, and the protection of life and property within the reservation boundaries; within the scope of their authority.

## **Employment Qualifications:**

A qualified candidate:

- Minimum of twenty-one (21) years of age; and
- Has obtained a High School Diploma or GED, Associates Degree in Criminal Justice or related field preferred; and
- Non-restricted Michigan Operator's License with the ability to be insured under the company's policy; and
- Is licensed by the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards (MCOLES), or is certifiable at hire.

Conditions of employment with Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Government includes, passing a preemployment drug test, a physical and psychological examination in accordance with MCOLES certification guidelines, an extensive background investigation, possession of a non-restricted Driver's License throughout employment and being insurable under the Tribe's auto policy, and successfully completing an twelve month (12) introductory period (based on qualifications at time of hire).

#### An employee must have:

- 1. <u>Passed academy training and obtained a Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards (MCOLES)</u> <u>licensure, or complete MCOLES waiver of training where applicable</u>; and
- 2. <u>The ability to obtain BIA Special Law Enforcement Commission during the introductory period</u> (contingent on availability of training).
