ZOOM INSTRUCTIONS FOR TRIBAL COURT PROCEEDINGS

CONNECTING TO THE VIRTUAL COURT ROOM AT THE TIME OF THE PROCEEDING:

- **To connect via PC:** Go to the Zoom Web Site (Zoom.us). Click on “Join a Meeting”. Join using Meeting ID & Pass Code listed above
- **To connect via cellular device:** Install the “Zoom Cloud Meetings” app from the Apple or Android Store prior to the hearing. Launch the Zoom app at the time of the hearing and join using Meeting ID & Pass Code listed above
- **To connect via Telephone:** Call 1-312-626-6799 or 1-929-436-2866 and use Meeting ID & Pass Code listed above. (If prompted for a Participant code, use the Pass Code.)
- **Zoom Link:** If you do not have the ability to download the Zoom app on your cellular device, please contact the court prior to the hearing to have a meeting link emailed to you.

COURT POLICY

- **PARTIES AND WITNESSES MUST APPEAR BY VIDEO.** Please download the Zoom Cloud Meetings app or request a Zoom link from the court before the hearing begins. If you do not have video capability, please obtain approval from the court prior to the hearing to attend without video.
- **ALL ATTENDEES MUST CHANGE THEIR PHONE NUMBER TO THEIR NAME PRIOR TO THE START OF THE HEARING.** If you do not have the capability of doing so, please contact the court and provide your phone number prior to the hearing.
- The Zoom meeting is a court proceeding and therefore an extension of the court room. Appropriate conduct and attire are required.
- The judge has the power over the proceeding and participants as if they were present in the physical court room, including the power to hold you in contempt of court.
- Upon entering the meeting, you will be placed in a “Waiting Room” until the Judge is ready to open the proceedings. If you join after a hearing has already begun, there is no guarantee you will be admitted to the hearing.
- Any messages or conversations not a part of the official court proceeding between the client and the attorney should take place either outside the virtual courtroom or a request can be made to the “Host” to enter a “Breakout Room.”

PARTICIPANT TECHNICAL EXPECTATIONS:

- Remote participants must use a private and quiet room that will be free from interruptions. Avoid rooms with bright windows or back lighting.
- The court does not provide technical assistance for testing or troubleshooting.
