- C. The salt spreader was installed on the 2018 Chevrolet 2500 Silverado maintenance truck.
- **D.** The department mailed out a letter/survey for the Housing Commission to all tenants at Aki maadiziwin that live in fair market housing to see if they are interested in purchasing their rental unit. The program is called Native Independent Home Ownership Program. (please see attachment)
