HOUSING DEPARTMENT ACTIVITY REPORT For January 2018

I. Housing Activities.

- A. The Housing Department performed a walk through with the Contractor on the last two (Aki 10) new Fair Market rentals on January 10, 2018. The walk through was originally scheduled for December 18, 2017 however it was cancelled by the contractor due to weather.
- B. As of the end of December 2017 we had not received the Window Treatments as ordered through Home Depot. Upon return from the Holiday break we inquired as to the status of the window treatments (blinds) with Home Depot and learned our order had been lost by them and therefore no window treatments had been ordered. As a result we reordered the window treatments and had to seek another Tribal Council Resolution to fund their purchase as the funding could not be carried over from our 2017 budget. We received the window treatments on January 18, 2018 and started installing the same day.
- **C.** The Department has been very busy filling the new units and inspecting those units where tenants are transferring to the new units.
- **D.** We notified our tenants of their new monthly rental amounts as a result of the increases to begin February 1, 2018.
- E. The Housing Department submitted our 2018 IHBG Environmental Assessment (EA) to HUD for the activities identified in our 2018 IHP. We received HUD's approval for the EA on 1-31-18. With this approval we are now able to make withdrawals from our 2018 IHBG when funded.
- F. On January 24, 2017 Tribal Council approved a resolution to transfer the Housing Departments five fair market and 2 short term income based rental units in the City of Manistee to the Economic Development Corporation (EDC). The transfer is to become effective February 2, 2018.

G. During the month the Department performed the following activities.

III. Condition of Properties.

A. Please see the attached daily log kept by the Housing Maintenance Technicians. This log is not intended to be an in depth description of the work performed each day, but instead a snap shot of their daily activities.

IV. Number of Units and Vacancies.

LRBOI Housing Department has 74 rental units in total of which all 67 were rented giving us an occupancy rating of 91%. This value is misleading due to the fact many of the new vacancies were a result of transfers to the new units so when we filled a new unit a vacancy was created due to a transfer from an existing rental unit.

- **A.** Aki has 57 income based rental units of which 54 were rented during the month as follows:
 - 1. Aki has 9 low income elder designated rental units and 9 units are rented.
 - 2. Aki has 2 low income elder ADA designated rental units and 2 are rented.
 - 3. Aki has 28 low income family rental units and 25 are rented.
 - 4. Aki has 6 low income family ADA rental units and 6 are rented.
 - 5. Aki also has 22 fair market rentals and 18 are rented.
- B. We have 5 fair market rentals in the City of Manistee and 5 are rented.
- C. We also have 2 short-term rentals in the City of Manistee and 2 are rented.

V. Significant Problems and Accomplishments.

A. Accomplishments:

1. Construction completion of 10 new fair market rental units. The Housing Department is waiting for the delivery of the FF&E in order to finish for occupancy.

VI. Plans for the Future.

A. Development of an Elders Apartment Complex at Aki maadiziwin. The development of the apartments is planned to be funded through Low Income Housing Tax Credits (LIHTC). Our consultant, Travois, informed us we should have a decision on our application in February 2018.
