7. Business: Commission went over Chapter 2 with Elise. Because changes in the laws surrounding domestic violence Shanaviah Canales wants to meet with the Commission to go over these rules before we make changes to Chapter 2.

Some of the ideas for victims were: to put Domestic Violence victims to the top of the rental list at Aki. To make a safe house on tribal land or to go into a partnership with "Cove" a domestic violence program in Manistee that already have a housing project set up.

Sandy Lewis brought up the idea of possibility of even starting a "Foster Home" for tribal children who are displaced in the tribe, so they would have a home to go.

Chapter 8 has been approved. Chapters 2 and 4 have been delayed, Chapters 1 and 6 are up for comment. Elders Complex Grand Opening will be July 18th. Michelle has everything in order for the opening, Commission will be on hand, along with Housing at the Opening. Hopefully everything will go good so the elders can move in by the 1st of August.

If any Elder wants to move into an apartment they have first choice. Same rules apply at the apartments that apply at Aki housing. They can have only one caregiver living with them. Visitors can stay for only allowed time. Commission and housing talked of a possible dog run for the elders who have a dog. Michelle is looking into a company for furniture for the Elders complex. Casino has no furniture at this time. Commission and Legal need to set up time with Family Services to go over laws pertaining to Domestic Violence.
