OPEN SESSION MINUTES

The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians held a meeting at the Little River Band Government Center on June 14, 2017. Following are the minutes of that meeting.

Recorder Lewis said to Speaker Riley that the recorder is on.

Speaker Riley said good morning everyone and he would like to welcome everybody to their Council Meeting for June 14th.

I. Opening Prayer

Councilor Wittenberg offered the Opening Prayer in Anishinaabemowin and English.

We thank you for this day, Creator.

We ask that you watch over us.

Help us in our hearts to make the right decisions.

Be with all that is above us, with us, below us and that is what is within.

We thank you for all we have and all that we don't have.

Ahaaw. Miigwech, Miigwech, Miigwech.

II. General Business

A. Call to Order

The regularly scheduled Tribal Council meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m.

Speaker Riley said Recorder Lewis actually has a couple of announcements that she would like to make before they get started here.

Recorder Lewis said okay, due to the passing of Stella Whitepigeon their Tribal Council will be out this afternoon for the funeral services and that will be located at 2724 West Maw Gaw Ne Quong. Lewis said Councilor Di Piazza is out right now and he is at the fire attending that. Lewis said anybody that would like to go and support the family and she asks that they keep their prayers for her family. Lewis said anybody that wishes to attend it will be over there starting around

noon and then they will be taking her down to Custer. Lewis said at 3:00 there will be a luncheon over at Aki.

Speaker Riley said to Recorder Lewis alright can she do a roll call to establish quorum.

Ogema Romanelli thanked him very much. Romanelli said seems like Wednesdays come sooner than every seven days doesn't it, every three days they have a Council Meeting. Romanelli said there is really nothing new to report. Romanelli said the Gathering Grounds Construction is on schedule so he thinks they are all set for their Pow Wow and going from there so. Romanelli said he wanted to thank Council for their......the discussions they have been having over the last week or so. Romanelli said just on a different note they are looking at the Budget and the talk of the Gathering Grounds then the needs that they have within the Tribe. Romanelli reiterated his thanks for that. Romanelli said this is going to be one of the shortest Council Meetings in a long time. Romanelli thanked them and asked if there were any questions.

Speaker Riley thanked the Ogema.

C. Legislative Affairs Update

Speaker Riley said onto Legislative Affairs Update. Riley said he just actually wanted to take a minute to welcome the Mayor of Manistee to the audience here. Riley asked if there was anything he would like to share while he is here.

James Smith, Mayor of Manistee said he would like to personally and for the City thank them for the generosity in the Revenue Sharing and the many contributions that the Tribal Government has made to the community as a whole. Smith said the many things that they would not be able to do in Public Safety without those funds without impacting the services of the City Government so his appreciation is great for their contributions and thanked them.

Speaker Riley thanked the Mayor of Manistee for his kind words and that it has been a pleasure working with him on their end as well. Riley said anything else for Legislative Affairs. Riley recognized Councilor Crampton.

Councilor Crampton said just recently the Government Accountability Office which is GAO recently targeted five programs or actually three as high risk for the BIA. Crampton said that would be the Indian Education, the Department of Human Services and Health Services. Crampton said the reason they placed them in high risk is because nothing is getting done in these areas and if it keeps going the way it is or does and they don't get things done then there will be some cuts to those programs.

Speaker Riley said alright if there is nothing further for the Legislative Affairs Update they will move onto Public Comment.

D. Public Comment Period

Speaker Riley recognized Recorder Lewis.

Recorder Lewis said she just wanted to update everyone they did receive a "thank you" card from the girls over at Manistee High School for the Cheerleading sponsorship for gymnastic mats and they will go ahead and get that also to the

Ogema because they were thinking everyone. Lewis said very happy those girls were.

Speaker Riley said okay, good. Riley asked anyone else for Public Comment.

Councilor Crampton said oh he just wanted to mention something.

Speaker Riley said okay and recognized Councilor Crampton.

Councilor Crampton said well this last Saturday he attended the Sugar Ray Concert that they had there. Crampton said his daughter got to go back and meet him and she gifted him a necklace that was made by his cousin from GTB. Crampton said he was just overly ecstatic and mentioned it several times in the show but what he felt that was odd back there was there was only like ten people back there to meet this very gracious band who embraced their culture and did such a great show. Crampton said he means they should look at maybe even having someone representing the Ogema somebody meet with him beforehand to show them their appreciation and tradition because he noticed that some of these shows that doesn't happen and maybe there was like four or five people back and these guys go out and do a great show for them. Crampton said just something like that.

Speaker Riley said okay. Riley recognized Recorder Lewis.

Recorder Lewis said she did want to state about that. Lewis said she thought that was very honorable of Sara Crampton that she gifted him the necklace, a beaded necklace that said Sugar Ray. Lewis said she did make a statement to him that is the Odawa way, the Ottawa way, is to gift someone when they come into the area so she just wanted to say "thank you" to her that was very honorable to do that.

Speaker Riley said okay, last call for Public Comment. Riley said alright at this point they will be moving into Closed Session.

The purpose of closed session is to discuss business matters considered privileged or confidential involving consideration of bids/contracts, pending legal issues, and/or personnel matters.

Speaker Riley said at this point he will entertain a motion to end First Open at 10:13.
