

Little River Band of Ottawa Indians -Camping Fact Sheet

Tribal Properties – Dispersed Camping of Tribal Property – Appendix 1

- Passes are obtained from LRBOI Natural Resources Department
- Tribal members must obtain a Tribal Lands Camping Permit from the Natural Resources Department
- Permits must be displayed at campsite
- Permits shall not be issued for more than 14 consecutive days
- Permit is at no cost
- See Camping regulations (R500-01: NRC-04) for more specific rules – Appendix 1

Gathering Grounds Campground (Campground next to Government Building)

- Passes are obtained from LRBOI Public Safety
- There is a cost associated with staying at this campground

United State Forest Service Day-Use Parking Passes – Appendix 2

- Passes are obtained from LRBOI Natural Resources Department
- Passes are free to Tribal Members
- Each Tribal Member can receive two passes per year
- Passes allow access to parking areas at Trailheads, Campground/Picnic Area, River Access sites on the Huron/Manistee National Forest.

US Forest Service Lands (Federal Public Land)

- No permit needed for **dispersed** camping on Forest Service lands

US Forest Service Campgrounds – Appendix 3

- Tribal members must obtain a permit from the Tribal Natural Resources Department
- Permit is at no cost
- Certain USFS campgrounds are fee-exempt, while others are not

Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore

- Tribal members can receive a lifetime pass to **access** the National Park from the Natural Resources Department
- Pass is at no cost to Tribal members
- There is a fee to camp at the National Lakeshore
- Permits to camp can be obtained at the National Park Service

Michigan DNR (Dispersed camping on State Owned Public Lands) – Appendix 4

- Tribal member must obtain a permit from the Michigan Department of Natural resources
- Permits are at no cost and can be found online – Appendix 4

Michigan DNR owned Campgrounds

- Campgrounds are not fee -exempt
