Position: Legislative Director – Tribal Council (Full Time - Regular)

- Prior experience working for or with a Tribal Government is required; and
- Extensive knowledge and experience working with Native American communities, culture, customs, and cultural law is required; and
- Enrolled citizen of a Federally recognized tribe or Alaskan native is required.
