Acting Speaker Lewis said they are going to take a moment out. Lewis said Jason Cross is going to speak about the Manistee Area Leadership Program who are here visiting their facilities today.

Jason Cross, Director of Family Services, said good morning. Cross said this is their third year hosting Tribal Day. Cross said it is a part of the Manistee Chamber of Commerce Leadership Program. Cross said what they do is they travel to different buildings and talk about the Tribe and things that they do. Cross said they just finished up with Jay Sam giving a brief overview of the History of the Tribe. Cross said they will stay for Council for a bit then they will sneak out and go to do a tour of this building. Cross said they are going to the Water Treatment Plant and they will have lunch with the Elders. Cross said they will go to the Justice Center for Director Medacco and Judge Bailey to give a Presentation. Cross said then they will go to Natural Resources Frank Beaver and his team will give Presentations on the things that they are doing. Cross said then they will conclude back here where Recorder Lewis has offered to speak with the group briefly at the end and any other Council Members who wish to join at 4:00 in the Law Library are welcome to do that to answer any questions that the group may have. Willis said this item represents Modification #3 to the 2018 Self-Governance Compact with the Bureau of Indian Affairs. Willis said year to date it brings them up to almost 16% of what they projected in total they are at \$301,381 and the projection was \$1,923,539. Willis said they just need to accept the money and amend the Operating Budget.

Willis said that money didn't all get spent in 2017 and so the balance of that is still available, the \$9,724, needs to be reauthorized in the 2018 Budget. Willis said Frank Beaver and Archie Martell are here to answer any questions Council may have.

#### VIII. New Business

A. Approval to Submit to United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) the FY 2017 Annual Performance Report (APR) for the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians as developed by the Housing Department

The APR was posted for Public Review and Comment for 30 days as required by HUD that are included. The Submittal is due to HUD within 90 days from the end of the Tribe's Fiscal Year beginning January 1, 2018.

Frank Figgels, Housing Department Director, represented this agenda item. Figgels said Boozho Council. Figgels said each year they are required to submit to HUD a report on how they use the Indian Housing Block Grant Funds for the previous year which in this case would be 2017. Figgels said this report is prepared by the Housing Department for submission to the HUD it is required that they submit it to them within 90 days of the end of their fiscal year which would be the end of this month and therefore he has submitted this report to them for their approval so he can submit to HUD.

Acting Speaker Lewis asked any questions, okay, no abstentions. Lewis asked Acting Recorder Di Piazza if they can get a roll call.

#### B. Approval of Building Regulations

Tribal Council recently approved the Building Ordinance. The ordinance calls for regulations to also be approved and these regulations fulfill that requirement.

Acting Speaker Lewis said they have Steve Parsons for this.

Steve Parsons, Planning Coordinator, represented this agenda item. Parsons said good morning. Parsons said this is on the agenda because last week Tribal Council approved the Building Ordinance which sets the parameters for building construction both residential and commercial on Tribal Lands. Parsons said one requirement in the Building Ordinance is that they promulgate a set of Building Regulations which really gets more into the specifics of the whole building process. Parsons said that has been done actually and they have been doing it for quite some time but it just has not been formulized into a set of regulations. Parsons said so what this is putting that down in writing so that they can give those to prospective folks who are building or thinking of building something on the Tribe's Reservation. Parsons said it gives them the specifics in terms of what that process is about. Parsons said so that is what is before them today approving the regulations. Parsons said once they have been approved they will get them posted on the website and also they can pick those up through the Planning Department as well. Parsons said so with that he will see if they have any questions.

Acting Speaker Lewis said okay any questions. Lewis recognized Acting Recorder Di Piazza.

#### C. Utility Rates Approval by Resolution

In accordance with Resolution #14-0226-043 the Utility Department is to become self-sufficient. The Rates are set-up to assist moving toward self-sufficiency as well as in accordance with the Utility Ordinance.

Acting Speaker Lewis said Gary Lewis is here to represent this.

Gary Lewis, Director of the Utility Department, represented this agenda item. Lewis said good morning everybody. Lewis thanked them for getting this on the agenda, Grace Hendler, and he appreciates that and apologized for the confusion on that. Lewis said on Monday he actually had an exam so he was at school for the work session. Lewis said so this is a request to approve the Rate Structure. Lewis said they had an Open Meeting February 26<sup>th</sup> from 4:30-5:30 p.m. and they didn't have anybody show up so they didn't take any comments.

Acting Recorder Di Piazza asked what did the rates go up to just for the membership. Di Piazza said just a quick synopsis, please.

Gary Lewis replied okay so if they do a comparison with previous rates and the current rate that they are proposing the water went up 3% for the usage and the sewer went up 2% for the usage. Lewis said if they would take an average residential bill in Housing that is 3,500 gallons a month and that is on average they are looking at a 46 cent per month increase.

Acting Speaker Lewis said okay any other questions.

Acting Recorder Di Piazza said so they can't hook him up in the city on his water, eh, because his water bill is almost \$100 now. Di Piazza said he was just curious. Di Piazza said he has been taking double showers and that don't work either.

Acting Speaker Lewis said if there are no other questions would somebody like to make a motion.

Councilor Lonn said she feels sorry for the people in the city.

Acting Speaker Lewis recognized Councilor Friedel.

#### C. Legislative Affairs Update

Acting Speaker Lewis recognized Councilor Medacco.

Councilor Medacco said he just wanted to mention yesterday he and Jason Cross was in Lansing, they had a Ceremonial Signing for Senate Bill 616. Medacco said it was introduced by Senator Emmins and also Schmidt. Medacco said it was an opportunity because Jason Cross did a lot of work on this so congratulations to him for everything he has done. Medacco said he was down there in Lansing too and he was asked multiple questions by the Governor and by different Representatives in the Senate about how this was going to affect Native Children. Medacco said this bill right here is just a stepping stone to the better things that is on its way, they know, the Tribes and everybody else is pressing forward to.

Medacco said so he just wanted to say thanks to Jason Cross. Medacco said also it was an opportunity for himself to go down there and represent the Tribe and thanked him.

Acting Speaker Lewis said okay anything else on Legislative. Lewis recognized Councilor Crampton.

Councilor Crampton said just that U.S. Senate Committee on Indian Affairs, Tommy Dell and Senator Heidi Camper, pushing for \$6 billion Opioid Funding that is going on because Native Americans and Alaskans have made up the largest population in the crisis to be affected.

Acting Speaker Lewis said okay anyone else.

#### D. Public Comment Period

Acting Speaker Lewis said that is going to move them onto IX D. Public Comment Period. Lewis asked do they have any. Lewis recognized Councilor Wittenberg.

Councilor Wittenberg said he would like to bring to everybody's attention that on April 5<sup>th</sup> they are having an Opioid Epidemic Conference and it will here at the Little River Casino across the street here. Wittenberg said if anybody wanted to come it is open to Tribal members and Tribal workers. Wittenberg said on April 4<sup>th</sup> which is on a Wednesday from 7-9 they are having a movie out and it will be right here. Wittenberg said it on the stories of different families that it has taken over in their lives and it is open to everybody. Wittenberg said the more that they can get involved the more that they can try to get......he can't say get it under control but he would like to see it. Wittenberg said it is ruining a lot of their families whether they believe it or not are having problems with it and the more that they can get that awareness out, he feels, the better they will be. Wittenberg said Miigwech.

Acting Speaker Lewis thanked Councilor Wittenberg and asked if there was anyone else.

Councilor Medacco said yeah he just wanted to make a comment. Medacco said he wanted to say "thank you" for the four Councilors that are travelling to Washington next week for MAST Impact Week. Medacco said just for them to show a presence there in MAST because four of them are going down there plus they have their Speaker who is going to Lansing for training also. Medacco said they don't have a meeting next week and their offices are closed on Wednesday. Medacco said so he just wanted to say Miigwech to the Councilors that are travelling to represent the Tribe.

Acing Speaker said okay so that is it for Public Comment Period. Lewis said it is Reaffirmation Day and their offices are closed next Wednesday. Lewis said so they will move into closed. Lewis said oh, alright, they will move into recess.
