

LITTLE RIVER BAND OF OTTAWA INDIANS POSITION VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

Position: Native Connections Program Coordinator– Family Services - (FT - Grant funded Position)

Summary: The Native Connections Program Coordinator is responsible for managing the LRBOI Native Connections Program, a community-driven suicide and substance use prevention program for American Indian and Alaska Native (AIAN) youth under the age of 24 years. This management will include communication, coordination and collaboration between the Be Da Bin Behavioral Health Department and partner organizations, including all school districts and colleges educating LRBOI Tribal members. The objective of the program is to enhance community outreach and engagement to youth who are at risk for suicide and substance misuse. This will be accomplished using a data- and community-driven planning process. The Program Coordinator will have direct supervision of all Native Connections staff, volunteers, services, and activities.

Employment Qualifications: A qualified candidate offers:

- Bachelor's degree in Social Work, Psychology, Public Health, Education, or Counseling or a minimum of five (5) years working directly with youth in a school or group home setting.
- Two years of professional level experience in at least one of the following fields: social services, education in a tribal college or similar institution working with tribal students; health/behavioral health care; or health/behavioral health education; experience working with youth at risk.
- Experience in the grant administration process.
- Demonstrated knowledge and experience in using technology/social networking as a positive community outreach and awareness tool.
- Proficient with Microsoft Office 365 and other standard Microsoft Office applications.
- Possession of a valid Driver's License with the ability to be insured under the company's insurance policy.
